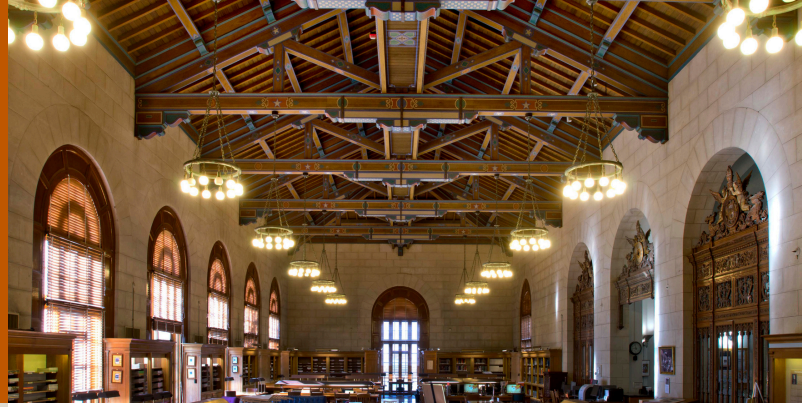




UT BUILDING EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT TEAM (BEMT)



OVERVIEW

The **Building Emergency Management Team (BEMT)** is a group of trained volunteers who support campus emergencies by guiding building occupants during evacuations, lockdowns, and other incidents.

They assist with communication, ensuring people reach safety and interact efficiently with law enforcement. These individuals perform essential functions that help keep their building occupants safe and secure while on campus.

LONGHORN ALERT



Longhorn Alert is the University of Texas at Austin's communication system, used to notify students, faculty, staff, guests, and visitors before and during emergencies.

ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

Building Manager

Coordinates training, educates occupants, and oversees evacuation drills and lockdown procedures.

Communications Coordinator

Relays emergency information between the BEM, BEMT, and building occupants.

Floor Manager

Guides occupants to safety, assists those with accessibility needs, and tracks individuals during emergencies.
